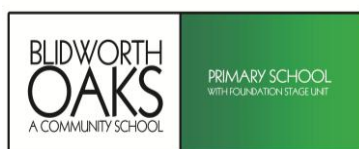

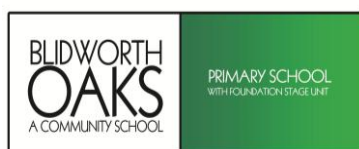
Parent/Carer Questionnaire Results Summary – January 2026

Summary of Written Comments from Parents/Carers – January 2026

Feedback from Parents/carers	School could support and aid parents more when problems arise.
School Comment	We encourage anyone who feels that school could provide them with more support following an issue to get back in contact with the member of staff they shared the issue with. If this is not possible, please speak to Mrs Ince or Mr Walker when you see them on the playground or contact the school office for them to get in touch with you. We are always open to ideas for how to improve the experience of our school community, so please look out for our upcoming 'Have Your Say' meetings as another opportunity to share your thoughts.

Feedback from Parents/carers	SEND Meetings should be with the SEND Leader and not teachers.
School Comment	In the majority of cases, a child's class teacher knows them best and is also best placed to support families when changes or adaptations are needed to school life. However, our approach to SEND in school is always flexible to support the range of learning needs we serve, so if you feel you require more specialist input from our SEND Leader please get in touch. Miss Radford is usually on the school gate Monday mornings or can be contacted through the school office.

Feedback from Parents/carers	Can parents hear more about what their child has been learning in Foundation.
School Comment	Those of you with older children will know that we used to use Tapestry frequently to share learning with families at home however, over time, we found that this process was reducing the number of essential interactions between the children and adults. We are aware that this has left a gap in communication between home and school and we are looking into different ideas to improve this for parents.





Other comments received by the school:
