Dear Parents/Carers

I am writing this letter to inform you that next half term, Year 2 will be looking at the RSHE unit Being Safe and Changing Adolescent Body. This will include the following objectives that can be found on our RSHE Progressive Overview. The full overview can be found on the school website: Curriculum - Year 1-6 Curriculum - Relationships, Sex and Health Education - RSHE Progressive Overview.

- List people who can support if worried and demonstrate how to ask for help.
- Understand they can say yes or no if someone asks to touch them and understand they shouldn't touch others without permission.
- Understand if people say 'no' their choice must be respected and describe what private means - Pants Rule.
- Know that private parts of the body should not be touched by others unless there are particular reasons why.
- Know when it is ok to keep secrets and when it is not.
- Describe how the body and mind reacts when it feels unsafe.
- Describe how they have changed since birth and understand the changes that happen as people grow from young to old.
- Describe how people's needs change as they grow.
