Sports Day 2026

Sports Day will take place on **Wednesday 3rd June 2026** on our school field at the following times:

- Upper School (Years 5 and 6) - 9.30am
- Middle School (Years 3 and 4) - 11.00pm
- Lower School (Years 1 and 2) - 1.30pm

Sports Day is a highly anticipated part of our annual calendar - we hope you enjoy yourselves; we hope the weather holds; and, most importantly, we hope all the children have lots of fun.

We have designed our Sports Day to be competitive and inclusive. All children will be competing for individual boys and girls bronze, silver and gold medals in four different disciplines for their age group:

- 1) Sprinting (heats followed by a final)
- 2) Long Distance Running
- 3) Throwing
- 4) Jumping

Every child will be awarded stickers on the day for their participation in each different event. Every distance jumped or thrown and every time ran will also be converted into points and all children's points go towards our school's House Sports Trophy, as well as the coveted Partnership 'Varsity' Trophy.

For the sprint event, once everyone has completed their heat, the child from each House Team with the fastest time in each year group will then take part in a Sprint Final and those children will be awarded a medal on the day for 1st, 2nd or 3rd. For the long distance run, throwing and jumping events, overall winners will be announced in a special assembly at the end of the week, once results have been calculated, and medals will be awarded for the top positions.

We appreciate that it can be disappointing for some children, when they feel they have competed strongly and still miss out on a medal, but we choose this approach to our Sports Day as we strongly believe that learning how to accept losing, in a supportive environment, is an essential life skill.

We look forward to you joining us - come and enjoy the day; cheer on your child, your child's House and your school!
