Educational Visit to the Workhouse and Infirmary, Southwell.

Dear Parents and Carers,

On **Friday 10th July**, our Year 1 children are going on a trip to The Workhouse and Infirmary in Southwell as part of their learning in History. On the day, they will explore and compare their life with that of a child from the past, including examining artefacts from Victorian times. We feel that this trip will really motivate the children and will give them a purpose for their learning during the term.

Your child will **need to be in school uniform** and arrive at school at the normal time. We should arrive back at school before the end of the school day.

Please note that your child is entitled to Universal Free School Meals and a packed lunch can be supplied for them for the day; please indicate on the online consent form whether you require a packed lunch from school, or whether you will be providing your child with one from home.

We regularly enrich the curriculum by taking our pupils out on visits, and subsidise as much of the cost as we can, however, in order for the trip to go ahead, we do require a voluntary contribution of **£15 per child**, which can be paid via the School Gateway app. We would be grateful if your contribution could be sent and the online consent form completed, using the following link: <https://forms.cloud.microsoft/e/mEZ4w4sGEO> by **Monday 22nd June 2026**.
